

Handbook for E-vote: how to vote?

When the election for the **Elective General Assembly** starts, you will receive an email with details about the election.

The email you will receive includes the following:

- Your Voter ID
- Your Voter Key
- Direct link to the election (Automatic login)



What is a Voter ID and Voter Key?

Each voter in this election will be assigned a Voter ID and Voter Key. Think of them as a Username (Voter ID) & Password (Voter Key).

Each voter will need to enter his Voter ID & Key before accessing the ballot. Thanks to this system, your election remains private, and each voter can only cast one ballot.

How can you vote?

The email you will receive contains a direct link to vote in the election, just click on "click here to vote" and you will automatically log in to vote.

What you are voting for?


The members of the CICC will vote to elect:

- one (1) Chairman,
- three (3) Vice-Chairmen (one (1) for Beijing, one (1) for Shanghai and one (1) for Guangzhou),
- one (1) Treasurer,
- eight (8) Board Members,
- two (2) Probiviri.


- Chairman: please, select just one (1) option




- Vice-Chairman (Beijing): please, select just one (1) option



- Vice-Chairman (Shanghai): please, select just one (1) option




- Vice-Chairman (Guangzhou): please, select just one (1) option




- Treasurer: please, select just one (1) option




- Board Members: please, select a maximum of eight (8) options
