



Trend 2006-2010


In the 5 years from 2006 to 2010, the number of the visas issued has almost redoubled. In 2008 and 2009 a small decrease has been experienced, due to the international economic crisis.

The amount of 2010 is the highest reached up to now.




Comparison with Schengen Partners

Compared to the major Schengen countries, Italy is at the 3rd place, after Germany and France.

The growth rate is encouraging, but there is still a lot to do in terms of promotion.



Timing and Facilitations

Peak periods excluded, business visas are issued in a maximum of 5 working days: 1-2 days to get the appointment; 1-2 days for the processing of the application; 1 day for the passport pass-back.

CCIC members enjoy the exemption from interview and some other facilitations (BFT channel), so that the timing is even shorter (3 working days). This special treatment is based on the principle that **CCIC** members are trustworthy partners of the Consulate.

Multiple Visas

In the last years we have also issued a certain number of multiple-entry visas, but without a specific "strategy". Multiple visas can be issued to qualified applicants, who need to go frequently to our country.
